Online registration:

Gymnasts who have been registered as competitor in IND/SYN/TEAM will be registered automatically in their competition parts, based on their year of birth and gender. The competition parts will be automatically printed on the competitions cards that are available as a download. It's the responsibility of the delegation to check the placement of its competitors after publication of the starting lists.

TECHNICAL PROGRAM

First routine with special requirements

Individual parts C01 until C06. synchronized parts C11 until C16.

(Also) in Age Group Competition up to C06 (C16), no Q2 is organized. The Qualifying Round in both Individual and Synchronized competition will consist of 1 (one) exercise with special requirements and without difficulty score, plus 1 (one) voluntary exercise.

For those Age Group Competition parts, The FIG Code of Points for Trampoline Gymnastics will apply with the following variations (according to the WAGC Rules 2022-2024).

11-12 years (C01/C02 & C11/C12)

The routine consists of 10 different elements, only two (2) elements allowed with less than 270° somersault rotation. Each element meeting the requirement must be marked with an asterisk (*) on the competition card. These requirements cannot be fulfilled by combining them into one element but must be performed as separate elements.

- 1. one (1) element landing on the front of the body,
- 2. one (1) element landing on the back of the body,
- 3. one (1) element with 360° somersault rotation, at least, 360° of twist.

13-14 years (C03/C04 & C13/C14) and 15-16 years (C05/C06 & C15/C16)

The routine consists of 10 different elements, only one (1) element allowed with less than 270° somersault rotation. Each element meeting the requirement must be marked with an asterisk (*) on the competition card. These requirements cannot be fulfilled by combining them into one element but must be performed as separate elements.

- 1. one (1) element to front or back,
- 2. one (1) element from front or back in combination with requirement N°1,
- 3. one (1) double front or back somersault with or without twist and
- 4. one (1) element with a minimum of 540° twist and minimum 360° somersault rotation

17-21 years and Senior (C07/C10 and C17/C20): FIG Rules

PARTICIPANTS

From the first edition in 2018, the Dutch Trampoline Open is an international, for each age group FIG sanctioned Level 4 tournament with over 350 participants in each edition; many athletes at World- and Olympic level have already participated in our competition.

The Dutch Trampoline Open is open to Representatives of National Federations, District or Regional Associations, as well as to all clubs affiliated in the respective Federations.

The participating gymnast must all have

- a valid FIG license
- a valid insurance

RULES

DRESS FOR GYMNASTS

National Identification or Federation emblem as per 6.6 FIG Code of Points is not required for this competition.

FINALS

FIG Rules for Qualifying will be followed (including group winners in Senior Class)

TIE-BREAK

Tie-break rules defined in the FIG Code of Points 2022-24 will apply.

PRIZES

Individual (IND) and Synchronized (SYN) categories:

Medals will be available for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in ranking; a complementary championtrophy will be available for 1st place in each category.

Teams (TEAM) categories:

A trophy will be available for each 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in ranking; complimentary medals will be received by all (max 4) team members and 1 coach of each honored team.

All competitors will receive a Participation Certificate for Individual and Synchronized competition.

TEAM FINALS (C30 and C31)

The best 5 teams of the Age Group and Senior class will compete in the Finals. Team coaches will be invited to be presented together with their team when marching in for the Team Finals.

The Individual qualifying round acts as qualification for Team Finals. In Senior Team Competition, the sum of the 3 (three) highest scores obtained by the team members in each round of the qualification will give the overall team score (sum op six (6)) after qualification.





Note: Due to the possibility of the competition office to rectify individual scores during the tournament, **the team qualification scores are final and complete after notification from the competition office.** Team scores in every other category only show the contribution from that category that is going to be exported to the overall team scores.

Teams in the finals consist of three (3) gymnasts. Each gymnast will perform one exercise.

Therefore, team finals are composed by three (3) rounds. The starting order for the teams in all three (3) rounds is in rank order, with the first gymnast from the team on 5th place going first, followed by the first gymnast representing the team on 4th place, etc.

The classification is determined by the sum of the ranking points (5, 4, 3, 2 and 1) a team achieves in each round. The winner is the team with the highest sum op ranking points in the Team Final.

In case of any tie, then tie break rules will apply (art. 4.4 TR).

PRIZE MONEY

in C09 and C10 prize money will be available: 1^{st} € 250 / 2^{nd} € 150 / 3^{rd} € 100.

JUDGES

Each participating Federation or Club with 3 or more competitors has to sign in at least with 1 judge. When 10 or more competitors are registered, they have to sign in at least with 2 judges. Judges must be available on both two competition days.

If not, a penalty of \in 25.- will be calculated for each competitor. The same penalty will be payable in case of withdrawal at any moment or last-minute absence of Judges.

All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline (TRA).

Service Packs (lunch/dinner on competition days and local transport) that are registered as "service packs for judges" <u>are free of charge</u>







REGISTRATION / ENTRIES / DEADLINES

Entries

Entries will be considered on a first come first served basis (online registration program) **Registration Link as well as a manual for the registration program can be found on the website**.

Entry opens November 1st, 2023.

Registration deadlines

In case of cancelation after December 31, 2023 it will be obligatory to pay all costs.

The participating Federation is responsible for covering all bank fees in connection with the bank transfers.

Note: only payments by bank transfer will be accepted before the indicated closing date. Cash payment during the event cannot be accepted.







CANCELATION POLICY

The LOC will email the invoice for costs for the participation and services after deadline of Definitive Registration (31/12/2023). Cancelation after December 31, 2023 will not be taken into account and can/will not be reimbursed (and in case of late registration will still be invoiced and has to be paid).

In case of force majeure, the LOC is to settle unavoidable costs in the first place before proceeding to a refund to the extent that is possible.

After December 31 2023, the registration program cannot be used for cancellation; it will **only** stay open until January 31, 2024 for

- Notification of alteration of participants or services
- alteration in e.g. pairs and teams, and for
- filling out (and downloading) competition cards.

OTHER INFORMATION

Medical services

Medical services (First Aid and sport therapist) will be provided by the Organising Committee during all training and competition sessions.

During competition, a sports' doctor as well will be provided.

VISA

Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the **Dutch** Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to **The Netherlands.** The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before **January 1st, 2024**

The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.

Transportation

International Transportation

The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members.

In case you book service packs for local transport/meals: The Travel Schedule Form must be sent in to the LOC as soon as possible, but at the latest **31-01-2024**

Local Transportation

Airport shuttle service and a shuttle bus between the hotels and the venue can be booked in the registration module (separately or as a pack together with meals). Services have to be booked and paid latest before deadline, (booking latest 31/12/2023; payment upon receipt of invoice, **latest 10/01/2024** by Bank transfer (see: Bank account information) **In case of cancelation after December 31**, 2023 **obligatory to pay all costs.**

If extra, not avoidable costs* are incurred because of any circumstance, not due to the LOC, these will be passed on to the Delegation. (**F.i.: Delegations Travel schedule, divided into multiple- travel moments, late return of the Travel Schedule Form or any alteration which leads to extra costs**)

Cancelation and reimbursement Policy is identically to the Policy which applies to the Registration fee.

Accommodation

Each Federation/Club will organise their accommodations themselves; bookings can be made at sales@zuiderduin.nl. [Use reference "Dutch Trampoline Open" to obtain children's discount and a special cancelation policy (up to 3 days before eta cancelation would be free of costs)].

Hotel rooms will be allocated on a "first come, first serve" basis. Beach hotel Golfzang is the one with shuttle bus service as before mentioned as "local transportation".
